SeeMore is a character that educates and empowers children to build a strong sense of identity and wellbeing so that they can keep themselves and others safe. The program has a strong evidence base and is internationally recognised. It addresses, supports and compliments: Early Years Learning Framework; Indigenous specific and remote community educational resources and other current Government initiatives – early intervention and protection, building the capacity of communities and equipping families to respond to situations specific to them.

Did you know that in Australia about 5000 children will go to a hospital emergency department each day because of injury? Childhood injury is a bigger problem than most of us know. This is the reason we are going out to 10,000 kindergartens or early learning centres and into 350,000-400,000 homes across Australia this year.

With your help we can build a generation of 'safety risk aware' children, whilst still allowing them to be kids. The answer to preventing injuries is safety, this is not something new, and most of the time it's just about making good choices. Our view is that safety is a wholesome thing which means to be safe you need to feel secure inside and out.

Please send an activity book home with each of your 4 year old children. If you require more books you can contact us via the contact details below. It would also be wonderful if the SeeMore Safety mascot and journal could start to make regular visits to homes with children. This is a fun experience for the children but also allows them to identify any safety issues they may find in their homes and around their local community areas.

We love to receive feedback and welcome good news stories we can share with others. Please have lots of fun with SeeMore and we hope the families in the centre benefit greatly from the program.
